



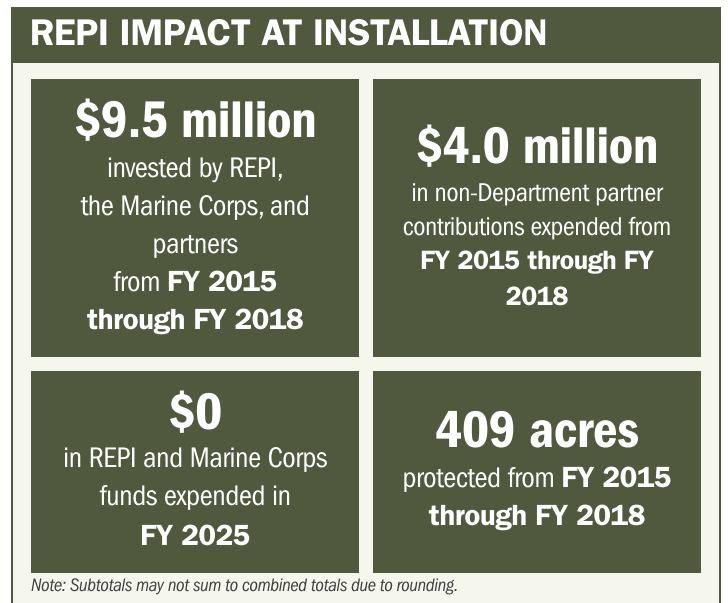
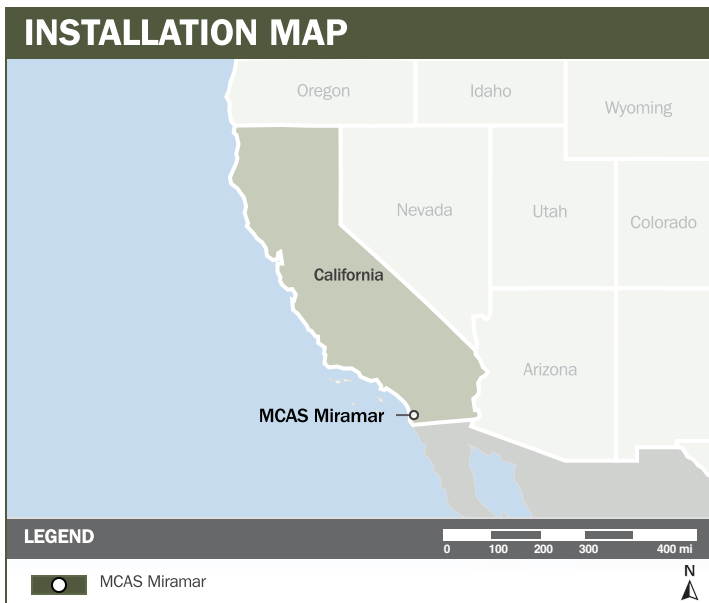
# MCAS MIRAMAR

## ABOUT THE INSTALLATION

Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar is the Marine Corps' premier West Coast master air station, located approximately 10 miles north of downtown San Diego. The installation supports the 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing, the aviation combat element of the 1st Marine Expeditionary Force and includes ground training areas for small arms and explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) training.

## STRENGTHENING MISSION READINESS THROUGH REPI INVESTMENTS

The Department of War's (DoW) Readiness and Environmental Protection Integration (REPI) Program has helped MCAS Miramar protect the installation from incompatible development and safeguard multiple threatened and endangered species. These efforts preserve training flexibility, reduce regulatory pressures, and ensure long-term access to mission-essential lands.



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

### HABITAT PRESERVATION—10 U.S.C. § 2684A

- Multiple threatened and endangered species under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) impose constraints on MCAS Miramar's military training, installation support, and wildland fire management.
- Acquiring land outside the installation for habitat restoration and impact offsetting preserves on-base lands for mission-essential activities.
- To address these challenges, MCAS Miramar is leveraging REPI funding under 10 U.S.C. § 2684a and partnering with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and MCB Camp Pendleton to develop and apply a recovery crediting methodology that provides ESA regulatory relief for military training.





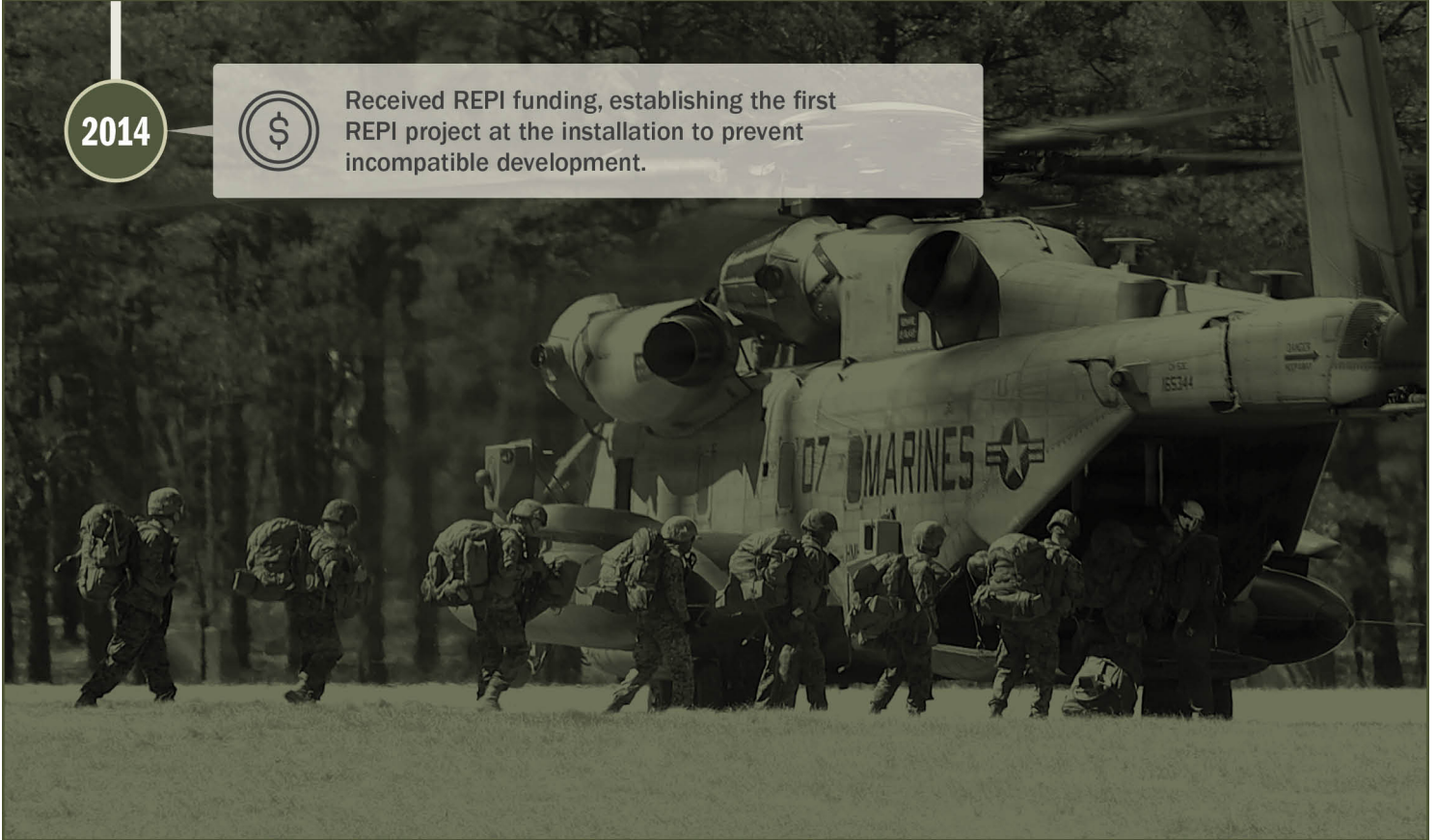
