



Installations Receive REPI Challenge Funding

The DOD Readiness and Environmental Protection Integration program recently announced nine projects that will get awards through the 2022 REPI Challenge. The projects "limit incompatible development, enhance military installation resilience, and protect local habitats to preserve and improve key mission capabilities," according to a fact sheet on the winners.

REPI is awarding more than \$31 million in program funds to be combined with more than \$60 million in partner contributions.

The recipients are:

- Naval Observatory Flagstaff Station and Camp Navajo, Arizona
- Beale Air Force Base, California
- Pacific Missile Range Facility Barking Sands, Hawaii
- Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii

- Pohakuloa Training Area, Hawaii
- Naval Air Station Patuxent River, Maryland
- Fort Bragg, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina
- Naval Base Kitsap, Washington

Proposals are being accepted now for the 2023 Challenge. Pre-proposals are due July 25, according to the official call for proposals.
